The Disciplinary Committee investigated the Erste Liga game EL 169 (Budapest Jégkorong Akadémia HC - Sport Club Csíkszereda) where in the 33th minutes Luke Santerno (Budapest Jégkorong Akadémia HC) penalized 5+20 minutes game misconduct slew-footing.

IIHF RULE 52 SLEW-FOOTING

“Slew-footing” is the act of a Player using their leg or foot to knock or kick an opponent’s feet from under them or pushes an opponent’s upper body backward with an arm or elbow, and at the same time with a forward motion of their leg, knocks or kicks the opponent’s feet from under them, causing them to fall violently to the ice.

The Referee shall, at their discretion, assess a Major Penalty and an automatic Game Misconduct Penalty if a Player is guilty of “slew-footing” on an opposing Player.

IIHF 52.3 DISCIPLINARY MEASURES

If deemed appropriate, Supplementary Discipline can be applied by the Proper Authorities at their discretion.

The Committee made the following conclusions:

The Budapest Jégkorong Akadémia HC player tripped his opponent from behind. Luke Santerno fouled his opponent by pulling his opponent's upper body back with his hand and tripping him from behind with his foot.

The Disciplinary Committee, considering all the circumstances of the case, upholds the penalty imposed by the referees on the ice and does not impose any further sanction on the player.
